Hence, the response that this year's effort received was overwhelming, and we were able to raise the funds needed to complete building the Middle School IT Laboratory.

School Project

In addition to our numerous donors, we were also most fortunate to have been joined by the family of the late Mrs. Chandra De Silva, former Vice Principal, through whose magnanimous gesture we were also able to fully equip the Laboratory with computers and UPSs. Below are some pictures of the fully equipped facility which is now ready to be handed over to the school. Supervision of the fabrication and installation was also challenging with travel restrictions continually being enforced, but we are happy to report that construction was completed and handed over well within the expected timelines.

A formal handing over of this laboratory will be organized and attended in person, no sooner travel restrictions are lifted and it is safer for us to gather. In the meantime, the school will utilize the facility as a space for teachers who are now fully vaccinated, to collectively continue with online lessons if they continue to be required.

Charity Projects

In early August, the Association also took the opportunity to participate in a timely charity project on a societal level, by donating three premium quality pediatric sucker machines (aspirators) to the Lady Ridgeway Hospital. These were in critical need at that time, with children's hospitals seeing alarming numbers of patients being admitted with severe breathing difficulties. The Hospital Administration was grateful to the Association for this gesture. A few images shared with us are below:



And in mid August, the Association also made a donation of Rs.100,000/- towards the care and upkeep of former Principal Mrs. T. K. Ekanayake. Our collective donation was readily matched by a generous Member, and together, a sum of Rs.200,000/- was deposited in the nominated account of Mrs. T. K. Ekanayake.
